

St.Kitts/Nevis Application Checklist

- Completed C1, C2, C3 and C4 Application forms
- Purchase & Sale Agreement - For Real Estate Applicants only together with Escrow Agreement
- Certified copy of current passport(s) showing name, photo, Citizenship/ Nationality, date and place of Issue, expiry date, passport number and issuing country.
- National identity cards – Must be signed/sealed/stamped by a lawyer or notary public
- HIV Exam no older than 3 months - the translated copy must be signed/sealed/stamped by a lawyer or notary public and must also be stamped and signed by medical lab or hospital which conducted the test
- Birth certificate/record – Two copies - Must be signed/sealed/stamped by a lawyer or notary public
- Marriage certificate and divorce certificate (if applicable) - two sets of original English or certified copies
- Police certificate from country of birth and each country that you have resided in for over 12 months in the past 10 years.
- A utility bill showing full name and physical address (No older than 3 months)
- Eight passport photos for each applicant - the forehead and ears should be clearly shown
- A Bank Reference Letter from an international bank where the client conducts their banking. (No older than 6 months)
- A Professional Reference Letter from a Lawyer or Accountant. (No older than 6 months)
- Letter of employment or Company incorporation documents and share register for business owners (For main applicant and spouse.)
- University Qualifications – certified true copy. (For main applicant and spouse.)
- Confirmation of University enrolment & transcript for children between 18-25 years old. (Children must be unmarried to qualify as dependants.)

St.Kitts/Nevis Application Checklist

■ Military records - Must be signed/sealed/stamped by a lawyer or notary public

■ Affidavit of support for children over 18 years old – done by main applicant

■ Source of funds declaration done by main applicant only.

■ Copy of any previous name changes - Must be signed/sealed/stamped by a lawyer or notary public

■ Passport forms for children under 15 years to be signed by both parents

■ Power of Attorney

■ Bank Statement for 12 Month Period

■ Affidavit of consent and knowledge is needed from the other parent when a single parent is applying with a child under 18 years old. The parent giving consent must also submit a notarized copy of a picture ID which also reflects their signature.

■ Due Diligence Fees USD\$7,500 MAIN APPLICANT

■ Due Diligence Fees USD\$4,000 for spouse and children over 16 years old

Please note that all documents must be translated into English and Notarized as St Kitts & Nevis are English speaking countries.
